### **MUSIC: On-line Registration – begins Oct. 25**

- **Choirs & Vocal Ensembles:** participants will be chosen in HPCS music classes by HPCS faculty; no runoffs.
- **Vocal Solos:** Run-offs for vocal solos (4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>) will be Nov. 30; Students should sign-up on line no later than Nov. 15.
- **Piano Solos & Ensembles:** Runoffs for piano solos & piano ensembles will be Jan. 19; Sign-up forms are due by Dec. 5.
- **Instrumental solos & ensembles (brass, woodwind, strings & percussion):** Runoffs will be on Jan. 11; Sign-up forms are due by Dec. 5.

NOTE: If your child takes music lessons from a teacher outside HPCS, and you have questions, please contact the Fine Arts Coordinator (above) for more information. All HPCS students are welcome to participate in Fine Arts Runoffs regardless of where they take lessons.

### **ACADEMIC TESTING: 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade & above – no sign-up necessary**

Classroom teachers will select students who are eligible for Academic Testing.

Students must have an A-B average in the subject in order to compete.

Tests will be administered in the Computer Lab on Jan. 22-26.
